

Missions of the Public Safety and Emergency Committee at the University Level

1. Prepare the programs for public safety and occupational health plans at the University.
2. Form periodic inspections of the workplace and develop appropriate control methods.
3. Classify the injuries and accidents related to work, register them and issue reports related it.
4. Follow-up work places that have confirmed an injury incident related to occupational diseases.
5. Provide fire extinguishers and first aid equipments.
6. Organize transportation to clinics and hospitals for the injured ones.
7. Provide specialized training programs for the safety representatives in faculties and departments.
8. Prepare educational and caution guidelines regarding the public safety issues and occupational health.
9. Create periodical check cards for Dangerous places.
10. Address the social security corporation in the event of a work injury or occupational disease.
